(1) Calendar year. Baseline is current law plus the extension of the lower rates on capital gains and qualifying dividends enacted by JGTRRA. Provisions include: \$5 million effective exemption indexed for inflation after 2010; statutory rate of 15 percent on taxable estate between \$5 million and \$25 million and 30 percent on taxable estate greater than \$25 million; repeal the state death tax credit (and do not allow a deduction for state estate taxes paid); repeal the 5-percent surtax.

(2) Tax units with negative economic income are excluded from the lowest income class but are included in the totals. For classifier purposes, economic income has been adjusted for family size by dividing by the square root of the number of members of the tax unit. (3) Includes both filing and non-filing units. Tax units that are dependents of other taxpayers are excluded from the analysis.

(4) After-tax income is cash income less: individual income tax net of refundable credits; corporate income tax; payroll taxes (Social Security and Medicare); and estate tax.

(5) Average federal tax (includes individual and corporate income tax, payroll taxes for Social Security and Medicare, and the estate tax) as a percentage of average cash income.
